## Band Camp checklist:

\*Bring these items to Band Camp every day!! (Drill charts and lyres will be distributed on the first day of camp)

-Instrument, music, drill charts, lyre/flipfolio, and **a pencil!!**

-A sack lunch

-A water bottle that you can refill

-Sunscreen and sunglasses (or a hat)

-A positive attitude 😊

## Dress code:

School dress code applies at camp. Please dress appropriately for the weather. Tank tops and sleeveless shirts are okay, but no spaghetti straps. Shorts must be an appropriate length. I would recommend athletic clothes, but as long as you're comfortable and following dress code, it's acceptable. You may bring sandals to wear during sectionals and at lunch, but athletic shoes with laces are required for marching rehearsal. (Yes: athletic shoes, converse, vans with laces. No: sandals, flats, TOMs, slippers.

Attendance:

**Attendance is mandatory.** Please refrain from scheduling appointments this week. Any and all conflicts need to be brought to my attention immediately. During band camp, we will teach the beginners how to march, we will review fundamentals, and we will learn the entire show. It is extremely difficult to learn the show when people are missing. It is also impossible to learn the entire show during after school rehearsals. It is imperative that you are at camp every day in order to achieve our goals. **This is the most important week of the entire season and your attendance is important.** You will be graded on attendance, participation, and attitude.

Lunch:

**There will be no off campus lunches!** Please bring a sack lunch to camp every day! Don't forget to bring a refillable water bottle. We will provide water to fill your bottle throughout the day.

Expectations:

As a member of the KCHS Marching Band, you are expected to be:

- **On Time** – you are expected to be on time to rehearsals and performances. That means here and ready to go by the time the event is scheduled to start. Plan to show up **at least 15 minutes** before scheduled start times. We will begin on time. Showing up late wastes valuable rehearsal time, and is a sign of apathy.
- **Respectful** – you are expected to treat your peers, your instructors, yourself, and your materials with respect. The band cannot function without mutual respect.
- **Responsible** – you are expected to show up on time with all of your materials. Keep track of your music and other supplies. Clean up after yourself. Make your section leader aware of copy needs as soon as possible.
- **Positive** – you are expected to have an upbeat and positive attitude. We cannot achieve anything under a blanket of negativity. Marching Band is a lot of fun! Show up to rehearsal with a positive outlook. 😊
